
How To: Create and Manage a Fundraising Team


- 1) While creating or editing your personal fundraiser page, you'll see the "Team Fundraiser" section.
 - a. You must have a personal fundraising page in order to join a team fundraiser



2) If you are joining a team, search for the team name in the drop-down menu. If you are creating a team, either select (New Team Fundraiser) in the drop-down menu or toggle the "Yes/No" button to "Yes"


3) Name your team, set a team fundraiser goal, and write a personal message for your team. Be sure to name your team something unique so people can find it easily. Setting a goal can help potential friends see how their donation is making a difference to your team. It can also keep your team motivated and engaged.



4) Your Fundraiser Team is ready to go! To further personalize your page, you can add a photo slideshow or edit the main components of your team's page. Clicking the "Join" button will bring people to the event registration, NOT to the fundraiser creation page.



5) You will see the names and personal fundraiser pages of your teammates at the bottom of the team fundraising page.



6) If there are other people you would like to have manage the fundraising team, you can set up additional fundraising captains. They need to have a RunSignUp account to become a captain. Captains can add photos, change the message on the fundraising page, see the list of donors and more.

You can allow other people to manage this fundraiser. They must set up a RunSignup account first. If they do not have an account, they can create one by visiting our Create Account page. Once they have an account, you can enter the email address they used to set up their account.

7) To access your fundraising page from the main RunSignUp site, click on the circle in the upper right-hand corner and select "Profile." Here, you can see the upcoming events, past events, and results from past races associated with your account. You will also see your fundraising pages and the teams that you're on. Here, you can edit your fundraiser, view your donations, send emails to people who made donations to your page, and view the team roster if you're a team captain.
